The fourth annual Dick Morris Memorial Girls Wrestling Tournament is **BACK!** This year's event is once again back at HBHS and will be held over two days. This event has been one of the toughest girls wrestling tournaments in the state with top CIF caliber teams and ranked wrestlers competing to make it to the award stand.

- Dates:** Friday January 17 and Saturday 18, 2025.
- Location:** Huntington Beach HS, 1905 Main St. Huntington Beach, CA 92648
- Weigh-Ins:** Weigh-In & Groom Check start at 8:00am on Friday and 7:00am on Saturday. Weigh-In order determined by team's arrival. There will be a 95lb weight class.
- Growth Allowance:** In addition to the January 2025 weight allowance wrestlers will receive an additional 11lb. on Friday and another 11lb on Saturday.
- Wrestling:** Wrestling will begin at 10:00am on Friday and 9:00am Saturday. Finals & Medal Matches will start at approximately 3:30pm.
- Entry Fee:** \$495 per team (14 wt. classes) by November 1, 2024, late fee after November 1, 2024, \$525, Teams with less than 8 wrestlers on the team \$50 per entry. If a team enters more than 14 wrestlers including the 95lb wt. class add an additional \$50 per wrestler. Coaches will receive 2 wrist bands. Each additional wrist band is \$10.00.
- Format:** Double elimination 40-woman bracket.
- Seeding Info:** All registration and seeding will be Track Wrestling. Registrations and must be submitted to Track on or before Sunday, January 12, 2025
- Awards:** Awards will follow approximately 15 minutes after each weight class finals. Awards be given 1st-8th individual, top 3 placers will receive tournament dry-fit T-Shirt. Custom awards, to the Champions, trophies to the top 3 teams and outstanding wrestler awards to lower and upper weight classes.
